

A Muncy Creek Township Supervisors Regular Meeting was held at the Township building on Monday, June 20, 2022, at 7:00 p.m. The meeting was called to order by chairman, Gary Phillips followed by the pledge of allegiance. The following were present:

Public Comment was called for. There were no comments.

A motion was made by D. Whitmoyer, seconded by D. DeMuro to **waive the reading of the minutes** from the May 16, 2022 Supervisor's Regular Meeting and **approve the minutes** from the May 16, 2022 Supervisors Regular Meeting as presented. Motion carried.

A motion was made by D. Whitmoyer, seconded by D. DeMuro to **receive the Sewer Authority minutes** from the April 27, 2022 meeting as presented. Motion carried.

A motion was made by D. Whitmoyer, seconded by D. DeMuro to **receive the WBRA minutes** from the May 11, 2022 meeting as presented. Motion carried.

Road Master Report – Business as usual.

A motion was made by D. Whitmoyer, seconded by D. DeMuro to **approve the low bid from HRI for Paving**. Motion carried.

A motion was made by D. Whitmoyer, seconded by D. DeMuro to **approve the low bid from Russell Standard for Modified Seal Coat & Fog Seal**. Motion carried.

A motion was made by D. Whitmoyer, seconded by D. DeMuro to **approve the low bid from DeAngelo Contracting for Line Painting**. Motion carried.

All of the above have been reviewed by the Roadmaster and the township's PennDOT representative.

Code Inspections Report – April report received. C. Newcomer let the township know that she noticed construction at a commercial building on John Brady Drive, and wondered if they went through land development. She also mentioned the fill on North Main Street at the property of Bob Shaffer.

Fire Company Report – May report received. Logan mentioned that the building would be starting soon, stormwater is set to be completed by the end of summer. The board was reviewing the estimates submitted from the fire company and wanted to know which water line estimate they were going with? Logan was not sure and would have to check with Scott Delany and get back to us.

A motion was made by G. Phillips, seconded by D. Whitmoyer to release the first phase of the funds for the MAVFC's new building stormwater, as budgeted, in the amount of \$13,340.00 (Inv. #: PO#4099-DRAW APP#1). Motion carried.

A motion was made by G. Phillips, seconded by D. Whitmoyer to have **Code Inspections, Inc. and the township solicitor enforce stormwater management on the property where Driveway's Express** is located on 405. Motion carried.

A motion was made by G. Phillips, seconded by D. DeMuro to authorize **advertising the stormwater proposed ordinance #22-52** for action at the July BOS meeting. Motion carried.

A motion was made by G. Phillips, seconded by D. Whitmoyer to **approve the donation, as budgeted, to the Muncy Area Pool Association for \$1,000.** Motion carried.

A motion was made by G. Phillips, seconded by D. Whitmoyer to follow Township Engineer, Dan Vassallo's recommendation in regards to **Mr. Robert Montgomery's stormwater waiver request letter.** In an e-mail dated 6/13/22 Mr. Vassallo reviewed the waiver request and permit, and recommended granting the waiver as long as any increase in stormwater flows is controlled by installed BMP's. Motion carried.

A motion was made by G. Phillips, seconded by D. Whitmoyer to follow Township Engineer, Dan Vassallo's recommendation in regards to **Mr. & Mrs. Dean Snyder's stormwater waiver request letter.** In an e-mail dated 6/13/22 Mr. Vassallo reviewed the waiver request and permit, and recommended granting the waiver as long as any increase in stormwater flows is controlled by installed BMP's, possibly connecting into the existing stormwater basin that he believes was installed when the dwelling was constructed. Motion carried.

A motion was made by G. Phillips, seconded by D. Whitmoyer to **approve the purchase and installation of new playground equipment at Kiess Park.** Motion carried.

A motion was made by G. Phillips, seconded by D. DeMuro to approve the quote from DIRSolutions for the township camera system, adding the PTZ upgrade, total of \$4,485.96. Motion carried.

Regarding Eric Newcomer's request for a microphone to record township meetings, the board stated that the public can record the meetings, but they need to provide their own equipment.

Public comments:

C. Newcomer asked where the money is going for paving, seal coat and line painting? G. Phillips provided details and costs. She also asked if Rich Opp's property on Lowe Drive was being paved as part of this?

E. Newcomer mentioned the issues with the website recently, has this been an issue, his concern is that the township has a website that isn't being used.

C. Newcomer wanted to know if the township was done with adding to the website? Do you have a list of items to add to the website that you are "ticking" off?

C. Newcomer regarding the money for the fire company, where is it from? Is there an agreement?

R. Bachle wanted to bring to the townships attention that Turkey Bottom Road is having a drainage issue, and needs to be graded, also the ditch is full and needs to be cleaned.

T. Snyder said they fire company should get their commitments from municipalities in writing.

C. Newcomer wanted to know if the financial statements had been received by the township from the fire company regarding where the donated funds were being spent? She said the fire company opened a separate account years ago.

A motion was made by G. Phillips, seconded by D. Whitmoyer, to **adjourn** the meeting at approximately 8:00 p.m. Motion carried.
